

## Streamline Ring



### <Material>

Art Clay Silver 650 Clay 7g	2pcs
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Completed piece

### <Step by Step Guide>



1) Wrap a ring size sheet 4 sizes (Japanese size) bigger than actual size around a wooden mandrel. Make a clay rope with 14g of clay, with a thick middle and thin tips. Roll it around by press lightly with your finger and dry.



2) Trim any burrs off the inside with a medium fine file.



3) Attach Self-adhesive Sandpaper Roll #320grit on a rubber block, and flatten the ring sides.



4) Sand with the file to make the ring rounded.



5) Attach Self-adhesive Sandpaper Roll #320grit on the mandrel, then smooth the ring inside and polish the entire piece with a red sponge sanding pad (#320-600).



6) Draw a guideline with a pencil.



7) Trace the line lightly with a craft knife, then angle the knife obliquely, and cut in.



8) Sand a V-shaped cut with a medium fine file to make a deep thick line.



9) Fold a sand paper (#600) to smooth the lines, and fire



10) Polish the entire piece with a stainless steel brush, then sponge sanding pads (red #320-600, blue #800-1000, green#1200-1500) and finally make a mirror finish with a polishing cloth and some silver polish to complete.
