

# ART CLAY™ SILVER Basic Instruction Guide

## Gothic Cross Pendant

Gothic cross pendant is an often seen item in silver accessories. Roll out the clay into your particular thickness, cut out with a design pattern, and make a texture with Paste Type. You can make different effects by using different textures.


Art Clay Silver Starter Kit	1pc
Art Clay Silver 650/1200 Clay Type 7g	1pc

### <Step by Step Guide>




1) Roll out 14g of clay into a rectangular round shape on the cooking sheet.



2) Roll out the clay into the same length of the design pattern.



3) Place cardboard on both sides of the clay, and roll out thinly with a mini roller on the cooking sheet.



4) Place the pattern on the clay, cut out with a moistened needle pin, then remove the pattern.



5) Take a small amount of Paste Type with a toothpick, draw small circles, and dry.



6) Smooth the outline with a file.



7) Trim and sand the edges of the piece using the round side of the file, following the pattern in the kit.



8) Make a pendant bail to thread a chain. Roll out any remaining clay into a rope the same length of the pattern, flatten, and cut out with the pattern. Then, put some Paste Type on the bottom of the pendant bail.



9) Attach the cross piece onto the pendant bail with Paste type.



10) Place a straw on the center of the pendant bail, then roll up the pendant bail to attach the end to the bottom with Paste Type.



11) Smooth the joint with a moistened brush, and dry.



12) Smooth the sides and pendant bail with a red sponge sanding pad (#300-600) and fire. Polish with a stainless steel brush, use some liver of sulphur to create a Gothic effect. Polish the concave part with a red sponge sanding pad, and make a partial mirror finish with a burnisher and finish.
