# - <br> A Pair of Puzzle Pendants 

## Level: Basic/ Intermediate


<Materials>

| Art Clay Silver Clay Type | 14 g for two pieces |
| :--- | :--- |
| Any chain | 1 pc |

## <TOOIS>

Cooking sheet, pencil, roller, plastic strips 2 mm thick, rubber block, plastic case, needle, toothpick, scissors, water, medium fine file, red sponge sanding pad (\#320-600), blue sponge sanding pad(\#), green sponge sanding pad (\#), stainless steel brush, burnisher, liver of sulphur, , stainless bowl, needle, straw dia.4mm, glass pot, chopsticks
<Step by Step Guide>


1) Prepare pattern sheet, place a cooking sheet on top and trace the pattern with a pencil. Turn over the cooking sheet and re-trace it with the pencil from the back side.

2) Knead 7 g of clay well and make an oval shape. Then, place the clay on another cooking sheet, place a pair of 2 mm thick plastic strips on both sides, and place another layer of cooking sheet on the clay. Roll out the clay with a roller to fit the pattern sheet size.

3) Make sure the pattern is traced. If the cooking sheet shrinks, move the clay to a different area of the cooking sheet.

4) Cut the shape out with a needle approx. 1 mm outside of the lines.

5) Dry completely so as not to distort and smooth the sides gently with a medium fine file following the lines. Use the file on the piece horizontally.

6) Smooth both pieces gently with a red sponge sanding pad.

7) Put the puzzle pieces together and fire at $800 \mathrm{C} / 1472 \mathrm{~F}$ for 5 minutes.

8) Cut the tip of a toothpick off approx. 8 mm from the tip with some scissors.

9) Smooth the details with the tip of the medium fine file.

10) After filing.

11) After firing, polish both pieces with a stainless steel brush.

12) Moisten the tip of the toothpick. Poke the end of the piece with the toothpick horizontally and rotate it to make a hole to thread the round jump ring through later.

13) Smooth both pieces carefully. TIP: Make sure both pieces fit together well before you proceed.

14) If you want to engrave words etc., trace with a pencil first and engrave little by little with a needle etc.

15) Polish with a red sponge sanding pad.

16) Polish with a blue sponge sanding pad.

17) For the antique finish, pour some hot water (70-80C/), add 3-4 drops of liver of sulphur solution and stir well. Then, put the piece in.

18) Thread the round jump ring with some flat pliers and finish!

19) If you want to make an antique finish, polish with a green sponge sanding pad.

20) When it becomes black, remove it with some tweezers.

21) Burnish the sides by pressing a burnisher strongly and make a mirror finish.

22) Rinse well with water, wipe off with some tissue and polish the surface lightly with a polishing cloth so as not to remove all of antique effect.
