## <TOOIS>

Cooking sheet, a pair of 1 mm thick plastic strips, roller, sponge sanding pad (\#240-320), stainless steel scraper, sandpaper, drill bit $\phi 2 \mathrm{~mm}$ and pin vise, flat pliers, pencil, spoon, craft knife, paint brush

2) Cut out the clay following the
design. Make 3 different circular

Cut out the clay following the
design. Make 3 different circular pieces.

5) Make a 7 mm thick rope with 10 g of clay and roll it out into a 1 mm thick strip.


1) Cut out the design pattern. Roll out 5 g of clay, 1 mm thick, with the roller.

2) Press the pieces on the spoon back to make a curved shape.

3) Cut into 3 strips, 8 mm wide.

4) After drying completely, smooth the entire surface with a red sponge sanding pad.

5) Moisten the strips.

6) Wrap a strip around each dried circular piece.

7) If you have any gaps at the join, extrude a small amount of syringe to fill.

8) Smooth the entire surface with the sponge sanding pad.

9) Expand the hole by cutting with the craft knife.

10) Remove any extra syringe and smooth the surface with the moistened brush. Fire at $800 \mathrm{C} / 1472 \mathrm{~F}$ for 5 minutes. Burnish the piece with the stainless steel brush and burnisher. Thread the chain through the 2 holes. Finished! (Option) You can attach beads and eye pin with the chain.

11) Cut off any extra clay with the craft knife.

12) Smooth the surface with a moistened paint brush and dry completely.

13) Mark 2 hole guidelines with the pencil on the biggest piece to thread the chain.

14) Extrude a small amount of syringe on the joins and attach 3 pieces together.

15) Smear the join with a small amount of syringe type using a spatula and dry completely.

16) Flatten the bottom surface with sandpaper.

17) Drill 2 holes with the 2 mm drill bit first.

18) Attach those pieces firmly.
