



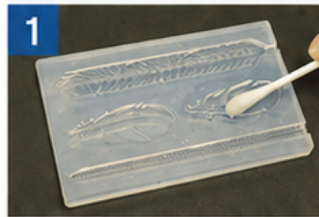
# Art Clay Original Mold Project

## FEATHER EARRINGS

### MATERIALS

- Art Clay Silver About 10 g
- Art Clay Original Ring Mold
- Oil (cooking oil, etc.)  Cotton swabs  Water  Hair dryer
- Hand towel or stainless spatula  Sponge abrasive (red)
- Firing equipment (gas torch, firing tray for stainless steel mesh, electric furnace, etc.)

### HOW TO MAKE



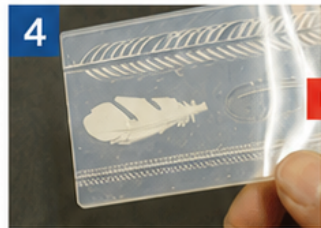
To make it easier to remove the silver clay, apply a thin layer of oil (cooking oil) to the recessed areas of the mold.



Be careful not to trap air. Press the silver clay from the center outward to fill the mold.



Moisten the surface of the silver clay slightly with water and smooth it with a spatula or similar tool.



Check from the back to be sure the silver clay has filled all the parts of the mold. Let it dry.

DRY



After it is completely dry, use a sponge abrasive (red) to smooth the back side of the silver clay.



Gently bend the mold and slowly peel it away from the silver clay. Handle with care when removing the dried clay.

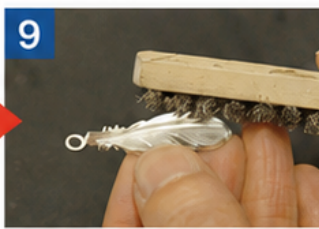


Use a sponge abrasive to smooth the surface and edges.



Apply a little paste to the back side, make holes with a round pick, and let it dry again.

FIRE



After firing, use a stainless brush to remove oxidation.



Polish the details with a polishing tool.



Attach jump rings and earring findings (ear wires, etc.) to complete the earrings.



## YOU CAN ALSO MAKE A FEATHER RING!

By adjusting the size and shape, you can create a matching feather ring.
